She has been the coordinator of the 2nd year of the Degree in Nursing and Coordinator of the Degree in Nursing. Currently, Secretary of the Department of Nursing, Physiotherapy, and Medicine. She teaches in Nursing and in the Official Master's Degree in Nursing Sciences. She has taught in the master's degree in Dementia and Alzheimer's Disease, in the master's degree in Public Health and in the first and second cycle of the University for Older Adults, at the University of Almeria. As professional experience she has worked as a nurse in different care settings from 1994 to 2018, with a duration of 258 months.
